

We've put together a checklist to help you look and do your best at your virtual job interview and get hired.

## **TECH**

- ☐ Use a laptop or desktop computer as they will create the most stable image.
- ☐ Download the software for the online platform in advance on this device.
- ☐ Check your internet connection to make sure it's stable.
- ☐ Make sure you set up a hotspot as a backup internet connection.
- ☐ Turn off notifications on your device.

## LOCATION

- ☐ Pick a spot in your house that is quiet and free from distractions.
- ☐ Ensure that the room also has good natural lighting or an electric light.
- ☐ If using an electric light, have it facing you and behind your webcam or camera.
- ☐ If sitting in front of a window during the daytime, close the blinds to prevent heavy backlighting.
- ☐ Find a location which is clutter free and has a neutral background
- ☐ Keep a minimum of three feet between the back of your head and the wall behind you

## **TEST AND PRACTICE**

0 0 0	Test audio and video to make sure they both work on your device Wear headphones to cut off external noise that you have no control of. Make sure the camera on your device is at eye level Put a sticky note with an arrow or with the words "look here" next to the camera Do a practice virtual interview with a friend or family member to familiarize yourself with the technology Record the interview so you can review how you look and sound online.
DRESS	
0	Check out the company's Instagram or LinkedIn to get a sense of its culture and dress one step above it.  Wear solid colors and avoid clothes with stripes or designs  Apply makeup a little more heavily,, partly to reduce the shine from the lights.  Also, avoid wearing distracting jewelry.
INTERVIEW PREP	
00000	Learn as much as you can about the company ahead of time. Review the job role and description Research the company culture Print out a copy of your resume, so that you don't forget key talking points. Prepare relevant examples of your achievements and experience. Practice answers to common interview questions. Prepare to discuss your salary expectations. Put together a list of relevant questions to ask the interviewer.
